The Surname

The surname, of Swiss origin, has been spelled many ways, perhaps fifty. An unusual spelling is Oufensanberger. In Switzerland it is WOLFENSBERGER, in Pennsylvania WOLFERSBERGER. One branch in Ohio changed the surname to Sparger.

The name originated at the village of Wolfensberg, about 25 km east of Zürich. In 1233 there is record of Baldebert von Wolfensberg. The name Wolfersberger first appears in 1446. There were many families of this name in Switzerland in early days. In German the middle name is the call name. John George was George, Anna Margaret was Margaret.

Switzerland

The ancestry of John Wolfersberger, who came to Pennsylvania, can be traced back to Jacob Wolfensberger, who lived in Ettenhausen (27 km ese of Zürich), parish of Wetzikon. Jacob was married at Wetzikon Oct 2-1575 to Elsbeth Knecht. These Wolfensbergers were living at 1467 Frederick, Conrad, Ulrich Ettenhausen:

<u>Alsace</u>

The connection with Alsace is given in Bulletin #66 of the Cercle genealogique d'Alsace (1984) by André Humm:

The family Wolfensberger is of Swiss origin. Hans Ehret (Ehrhart) Wolfsperger, son of Ulrich Wolfensberger of Ettenhausen, Canton Zürich, was married May 8-1689 at the Reformed church of Strasbourg-Wolfisheim to Ursula Emm, native of Buchiberg, near Berne. He was converted to Catholicism and moved to Wolschheim, where died Jul 12-1740.

Erhart likely migrated to Alsace in the late 1680s. He was married at 22. There is record of only one child, John, born about 1694, went to Pennsylvania in 1730.

The church records at Mattstall show:

1721, married Monday, the 27 January, Joh. Wolffisberger, son of Joh. Erhard Wolffisberger, citizen at Wolschheim, and Ann Margaretha, maiden daughter of Phillipp Entzminger, smith and resident at Mattstall. (LDS 767.276)

Margaret was a daughter of Philip Ensminger, Jr and his wife, Elizabeth. She was baptized at the church at Durstel:

1697, Feast of Matthae, Catharina Margaretha, daughter of Philip Enssmenger and Elisabetha, was baptized.

Sponsors: Johann Schmidt, smith of Wolffskirch
Bartholomaeus Eberhardt, single carpenter

tholomaeus Eberhardt, single carpent apprentice of Durstel

Catharine Elisabetha, daughter of Johann George Dieter, weaver of Durstel

Anna Margaretha, daughter of Georg Nicolai Quirin, rentmaster at Wolffskirth (LDS 729,715)

Philip Ensminger, Sr 1639-1712 lived at Waldhambach.

The Mattstall records also show:

Johan Peter was born Thursday the 16th October 1721 at Mattstall; baptized there Sunday the 19 October; son of Joh. Wolffisberger and Anna Margaretha born Entzminger. Godparents were:

Joh. Peter Knobel, carpenter there

Joh. Emming, citizen and nailsmith in Uttenhofen Maria Catharina Trauttmänn, wife of Joh. Peter Entzminger, citizen and smith in Mattstall

John and Margaret moved a few miles to Langensoutlzbach where these records are found: (LDS 717,247)

On 8 September 1727 is in Soultzbach buried Maria Ursula, little daughter of Hans Wolffenberger and Margaretha Ensminger. Age 3 years, 10 days

1 June 1727 Soultzbach, Johannes Wolffsberger (farmer) and his wife Margaretha Enszminger, a little son baptized and named Jacob Frederick, Godparents:

Jacob Bohli, Gastgeber at Löwen Anna Maria, wife of Jacob Sagerberger

Joh. Friedrich Müller, son of Hans Müller, miller Maria Elizabetha, surviving daughter of Hans Michael Weymer

John Wolfersberger, Jr was born in Alsace shortly before the family left for America, for he was naturalized in 1761. His baptism record has not been found. The younger children were born in Pennsylvania.

Pennsylvania

John Wolfersberger landed at Philadelphia August 29-1730. With him were his wife, Margaret 33, sons, Peter 9, Frederick 3, John a babe. They had traveled down the Rhine to Rotterdam, Holland. Here they boarded the ship Thistle of Glasgow and crossed the channel to Dover, England. The ship cleared Dover June 19. On board were 77 men - a total of 260 passengers - 73 were from Ludwigshafen on the Rhine. When John Wolfersberger signed the oath of allegiance at the Philadelphia courthouse, he gave his name to the clerk, who wrote it as Wolfer Sperger. John made an A between the two words. The family settled near friends or relatives in Lancaster County.

John Wolfersberger was granted 100 acres in Earl Township February 20-1734. He did not carry through, perhaps because he had not been naturalized. The land was patented December 3-1741 by Ludwig Mohler. While living here, daughter Catharine was baptized at the Muddy Creek Lutheran Church on September 17-1733. Sponsor was Catharine Gröningen.

About 1736 John moved about 10 miles to the northwest, now Heidelberg Township, Lebanon County. On April 11-1744 he was naturalized and immediately applied for 350 acres. The survey showed 671 acres. He paid rent from March 1-1737. (All rents began on March 1.) This suggests a 1736 settlement. He died on this land.

In 1752 the Heidelberg tax list shows John (Sr), Peter and Frederick. John, Jr had just turned 21 and is not listed. Peter was naturalized September 24-1755, Frederick April 11-1761 and John, Jr September 13-1761. A patent was issued May 6-1761 (Patent Book AA 1, 540) to the children of John Wolfersberger, who died intestate:

Peter, Frederick, John, Philip, Catharine wife of Jacob Tuy, Anna Maria wife of Martin Hefflefinger.

John's wife, Margaret died in 1775. She is buried at Schaefferstown, "Margreda Wolfersperger" born 21 September 1697, died December 1775.

The most prominent of the children was Philip. He was born in Heidelberg Township in 1739. He was a blacksmith. In 1763 he served under Colonel Henry Bouquet in western Pennsylvania. He was a lieutenant under Captain Henry Sheaffer in 1775 and a lieutenant under Colonel Curtis Grubb in the Flying Camp in 1776, going to Long Island. After the Revolution he became a colonel in the militia. He died in 1824 at Campbelltown. A copy of his family Bible is at the Historical Society in Philadelphia.

Peter and Frederick died in Heidelberg Township. Their wills name their children. Peter's was written March 2-1793 and probated October 14-1802. Frederick's was written April 14-1764 and probated soon after.

Migration to the South and West

(George) Michael, son of Peter went to Culpeper Co, Va. John, Jr went to Shenandoah Co, Va. Frederick's son John went to Greenbrier Co, now W Va - later to Ohio. John III went to Surry Co, N C - later to Ohio. Four sons of John, Jr went to Greenbrier Co. Three moved on. Peter died in Knox Co, Tenn; Benjamin in Wythe Co, Ya; Philip in Pike Co, Ohio. Frederick likely stayed in Greenbrier.

John Wolfersberger, Jr, a wheelwright, "of Pennsylvania", bought 2 lots in Woodstock, Shenandoah Co, Va April 3-1769. When he sold them 2 years later on November 5-1771 he was "of Woodstock". On March 16-1771 he took the oath as vestryman of Beckford Parish. He died in November 1788. His children are named in Shenandoah Deed Book K, 496. All of his sons except Joseph left Shenandoah County.

 earliest record of Ensminger is at Diemeringen, near Waldhambach.
 Here Carl Ensminger, son of Hans (a tanner) and Christina Ensminger,

was baptized July 14-1605. The deaths of Hans Ensminger in 1630 and Peter in 1633 are recorded. Jacob Ensminger was a godfather at Diemeringen March 19-1631.

Jacob may have been a son of Hans and the father of these three brothers who died at Waldhambach:
