





LEBANON BOROUGH.

LEBANON was laid out in the year 1750 by George Steitz, after whom the town was, for a while, called "Steitztown." In 1813, when the county was organized, the name of the town was changed to Lebanon. In 1817 the Harrisburg and Reading Turnpike was constructed which runs through the centre of the town. The Union Canal was built in 1827 which passes north of the borough. The building of the canal gave an impetus to its growth and insured its prosperity.

In the year 1855 the Lebanon Valley Railroad was constucted, which runs through the borough. The business of the railroad at first was small, and only required one train a day, but increased rapidly in both freight and passengers. Their business now compels them to run six trains a day each way, besides the immense freightage.

North Lebanon was incorporated into a Borough in 1855, and then included the land lying between the old borough and the Union Canal, together with a considerable tract contiguous to this, and just north of the canal. Four years afterwards it was reduced in size by making the canal its northern limit, the upper portion reverting back to North Lebanon township. The two boroughs grew side by side and in rivalry, but the construction of the Lebanon Valley Rail road, which passed through the old borough, and was completed in 1858, soon sent it far ahead in the race of progress. Manufacturing establishments were put up, and new dwellings extended the town on every side. The Borough was divided into two wards, the East Ward and the West Ward, in 1854; the streets were regularly graded in 1857, and gas was introduced soon afterwards, and in 1872 water was introduced.

The Boroughs of Lebanon and North Lebanon were con-

solidated in 1867. The act of consolidation created six wards in the new "Borough of Lebanon," the East Ward of the old borough being divided into the 1st and 4th, and West Ward into the 2d and 3d while North Lebanon Borough was separated into the 5th and 6th wards. It is regularly laid ou. with wide streets running north and south, and east and west Those streets which run north and south, take their names from their numerial order, beginning with First and ending with Sixteenth. Cumberland Street, running east and west through the centre of the town, intersects these at right angles, dividing them into North and South First. North and South Second. &c. South of Cumberland and parallel with it, we have Chestnut, Walnut and Locust; north of Cumberland are Willow, Scull, Church, Lehman, Mifflin and Guilford. The houses are numbered according to this simple plan.

The population of the borough in 1874 (taken expressly for the Lebanon Directory) we give below, as also the census
